1938-2007***

Dr. Seyed Rooholamini died suddenly on February 1, 2007 at his home in Granada Hills, CA. He was Vice Chairman, Residency Program Director and Chief of Body CT Section in the Department of Radiological Sciences, Olive View-UCLA Medical Center and Professor, Department of Radiological Sciences, David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA since 1989.

Dr. Rooholamini was born in Kerman, Iran, in 1938, and received his M.D. degree from Tehran University in 1962. He served his internship at Queens Hospital, New York City, NY, and radiology residency at Yale University, New Haven, CT during 1963-1967, followed by a fellowship in Cardiovascular Radiology at Stanford University, Stanford, CA and certification by the American Board of Radiology in 1968.

His first appointments were Instructor in Radiology at Mashad University School of Medicine and Dentistry, and Chairman of the Radiology Department at Shafa Rehabilitation Hospital in Tehran, Iran, from 1970-1985.

Dr. Rooholamini was an accomplished physician, knowledgeable scholar, outstanding teacher, and exceptional radiologist, but above all he was born to be a noble and kind man. His wife, daughter, colleagues and friends have contributed to establish the Rooholamini Memorial Fund in his honor.
